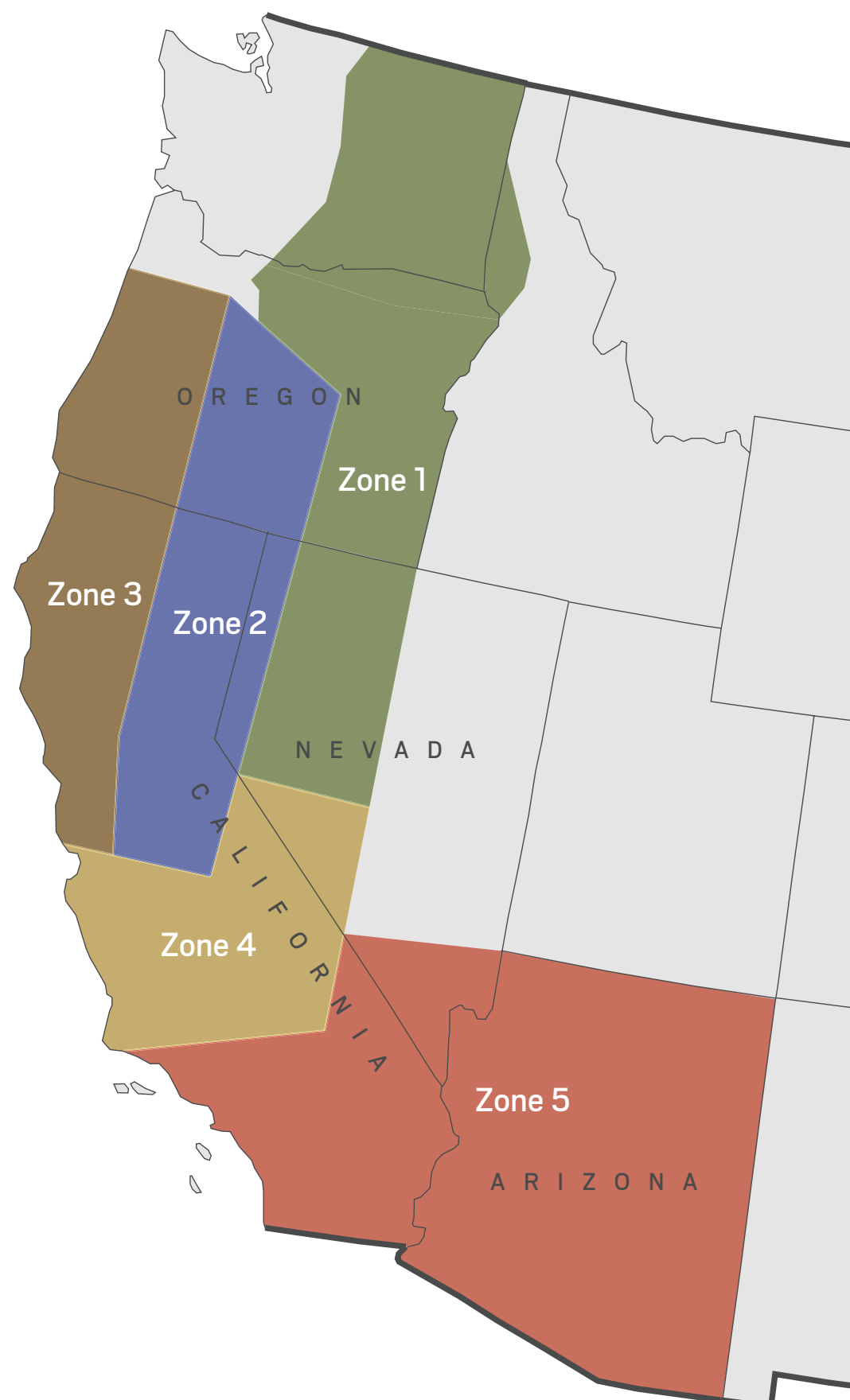
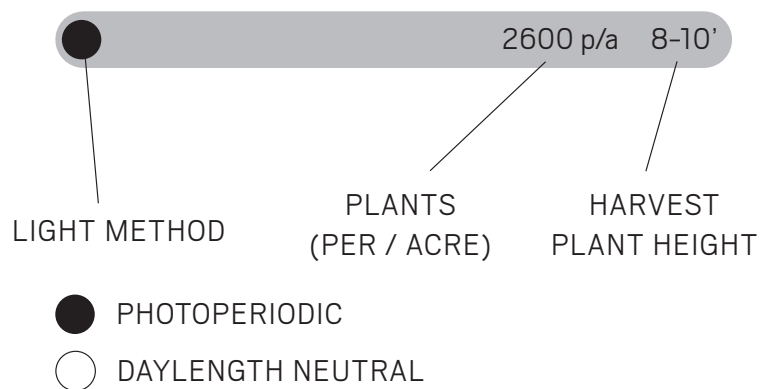


# Seed Planting Zones

- This map and corresponding seeding chart is for education purposes only. Do not base planting decisions on this information without consulting your Agrarian certified agronomist.
- Zones 1, 2 & 3 constraints are typically first/last frost dates and heavy winter rain.
- Zone 4 & 5 constraints are excessive summer heat inappropriate for seeding or transplanting young plants.
- All yields assume 1500-2500 usable extractable biomass regardless of individual plant size.
- Early-planted photoperiodic varieties will have more overall total biomass, but similar total extractable cannabinoids.
- Planting densities correspond directly to expected plant size.
- Day-neutral varieties have same days-to-maturity (DTM) regardless of season, but growing degrees and light units affect plant size.
